Top-Down Katniss Hat

this pattern is an adaptation of the M@ssy Bun Katniss Hat by Bell@ Haken &ZOO

Materials:

#4 worsted weight yarn H/5.00mm hook G/4.25mm hook Darning needle (for weaving in ends)

Gauge:

7 dc x 4 rows = 2x2inches (with H hook)

Finished Size:

8.5in tall x 9in wide

Abbreviations:

Ch- chain SI st- slip stitch Sc- single crochet Dc- double crochet Fpsc- front post single crochet Fpdc-front post double crochet Bpdc- back post double crochet Blo- back loop only

Notes:

• Chain 2 does not count as a stitch

The hat:

With H hook

R1: make magic circle, ch 2, 10 dc in the magic circle, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [10]

R2: ch 2, 2 dc in each stitch around, sl st to the first double crochet of the round to join [20]

R3: ch 2, *1 dc in the first stitch, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat around 9 more times, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [30]

R4: ch 2, *1 dc in each of the first 2 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat around 9 more times, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [40]

R5: ch 2, *1 dc in each of the first 3 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat around 9 more times, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [50]



R6: ch 2, *1 dc in each of the first 4 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat around 9 more times, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [60]

R7: ch 1, 1 fpsc in every stitch across, join by taking out your hook placing it through the back of the first dc from previous round and pulling the yarn through [60]

R8: ch 2, (you are working in the stitches from the previous row) *1 dc in each of the first 5 stitches, 2 dc in the next stitch*, repeat around 9 more times, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [70]

R9: ch 2, *fpdc in first stitch, bpdc in next stitch*, repeat around the hat, sl st to the first fpdc of the round to join [70]

R10: ch 1, 1 fpsc in every stitch across, join by taking out your hook placing it through the back of the first dc from previous round and pulling the yarn through [70)

R11: ch 2, (you are working in the stitches from the previous row) dc in each stitch across, sl st to the first dc of the round to join [70]

R12: repeat R10

R13: repeat R11

R14: repeat R9

R15: repeat R10

R16: repeat R11

R17: repeat R10

R18: repeat R11

R19: repeat R9

R20: ch 1, sc in each stitch across, sl st to the first sc to join (continue on to brim)

The brim:

Switch to G hook

R1: ch 9, starting from the 2nd chain from the hook, sc in each stitch across, sl st into each of the next 2 stitches of the hat, ch1, turn [8]

R2: ignoring the 2 slip stitches from the previous round, sc in the blo in each stitch across, ch 1, turn [8]

R3: sc in the blo in each stitch across, slip stitch into each of the next 2 stitches of the hat, ch1, turn [8]

R4-R70: Repeat R2 and R3 until you reach the beginning

Turn hat inside out, bring both ends of the brim together, and slip stitch through both thicknesses to join. Fasten off and weave in ends.
